In recognition of your hard work and commitment to this very important program, please accept this Certificate of Appreciation. We look forward to working with you again next year.

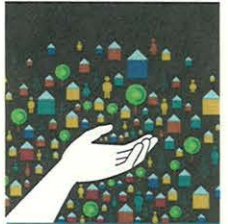
