Recommendation

1. That Report CAOR-RP-13-21 be received; and
2. That Kasian Architecture Ontario Inc. be awarded the contract to provide prime consultant services for the Rockwood Terrace Redevelopment for a total fixed fee of \$2,504,530 excluding HST, to be taken from the LTC Redevelopment Reserve.

Executive Summary

Colliers Project Leaders, on behalf of Grey County, issued a request for proposal to determine the preferred firm to fulfill the duties of prime consultant (architect) for the Rockwood Terrace Long Term Care Home redevelopment. Colliers and staff are recommending the firm Kasian Architecture Ontario Inc., be awarded the contract.

Background and Discussion

The RFP to provide prime consultant services for the Rockwood Terrace long term care redevelopment project was posted to Bonfire on September 7, 2021 and closed on October 8, 2021. A summary of the process, the evaluation and a recommendation from Colliers Project Leaders is appended to the end of this report.

Legal and Legislated Requirements

Grey County will enter into an agreement with Kasian as outlined in the RFP, with Schedule A1 Architects Services attached to the OAA Standard Form of Contract for Architect's Services OAA 600-2013 with July 1, 2018 Amendments.

The Rockwood Terrace project will be delivered using a Design, Bid, Build approach using a CCDC2 Stipulated Sum form of contract.

Financial and Resource Implications

The total cost of the contract is \$2,504,530 excluding HST. The funds will be drawn from the LTC Redevelopment Reserve.

The purpose of this Memo is to summarize the Request for Proposal (RFP) process including the evaluation process and to provide a recommendation to award for review and approval by the GreyCounty Long-Term Care Redevelopment Task Force.

Summary of RFP Process

The RFP was prepared by Colliers Project Leaders, reviewed, and approved Grey County and issued on September 7th, 2021, via the Grey/Bonfire electronic portal.

Milestone dates:

- Deadline for Proponents questions: September 24th, 2021
- RFP closing Date and Time: 2:00:00 p.m. EST on October 7th,

2021A total of five (5) addenda were issued as summarized below:

- Addendum 1 – Issued on September 23rd, 2021
- Addendum 2 – Issued on September 23rd, 2021
- Addendum 3 – Issued on September 24th, 2021
- Addendum 4 – Issued on September 29th, 2021
- Addendum 5 – Issued on September 30th, 2021

A total of five (5) proposals were submitted through the Grey/Bonfire electronic portal.

Summary of Evaluation Process

Proposals were read and evaluated by an Evaluation Committee comprised of members from Colliers Project Leaders and Grey County. Proposals were evaluated against a set of pre-defined criteria and weighting that was stated as part of the RFP, using a four (4) stage process. Proposals were first evaluated against the mandatory criteria. Proposals that met the mandatory criteria advanced to the technical evaluation stage, followed by

interviews/reference checks (for short-listed proponents) and lastly the evaluation of cost criteria. For reference, the point distribution is summarized in the table below.

Recommendation and Award

Following the RFP evaluation, Kasian Architecture Ontario scored the highest combined technical and financial score. On this basis, Colliers recommends that the contract be awarded to Kasian Architecture Ontario in the amount of \$2,504,530 (excluding HST).
