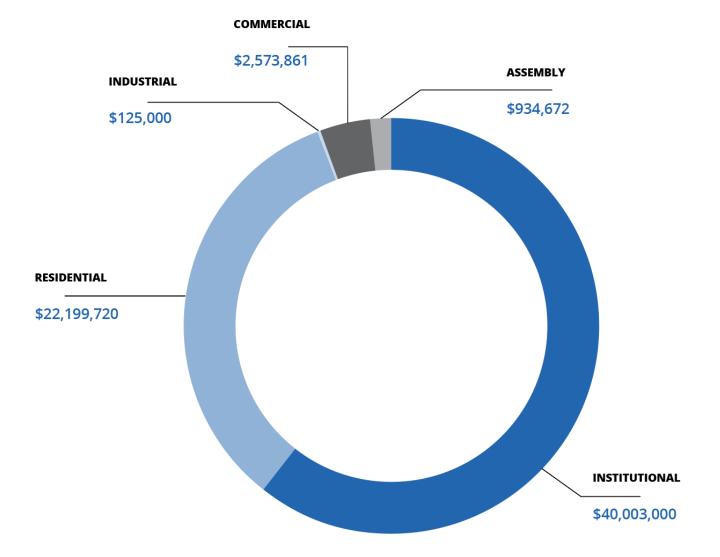

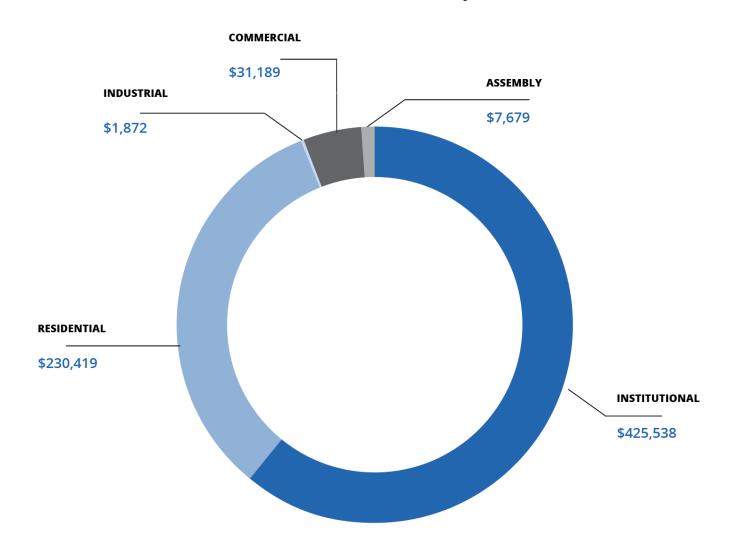


2020 Building Statistics Total Construction Value - \$67 million



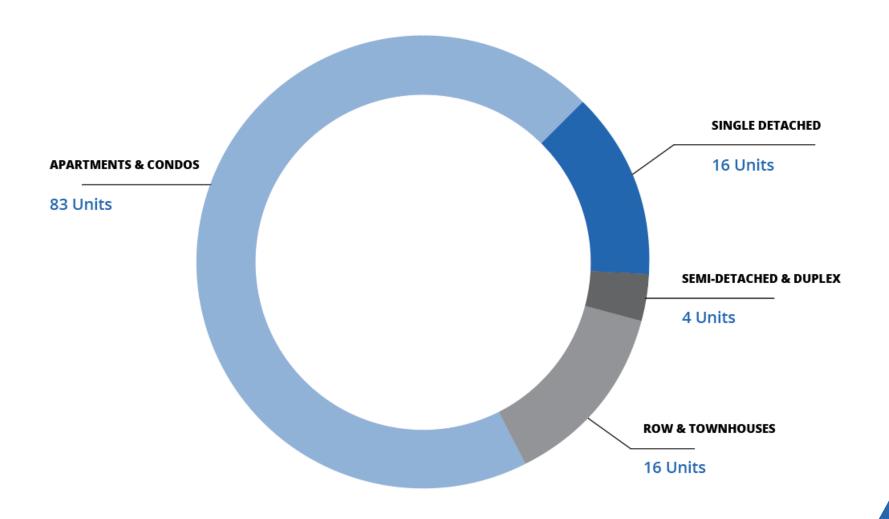


2020 Building Statistics Total Permit Fees - \$696,697





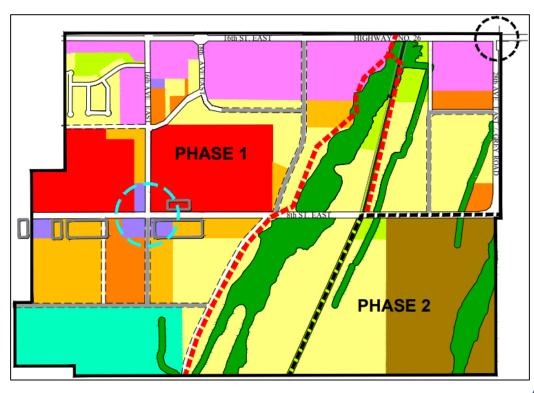

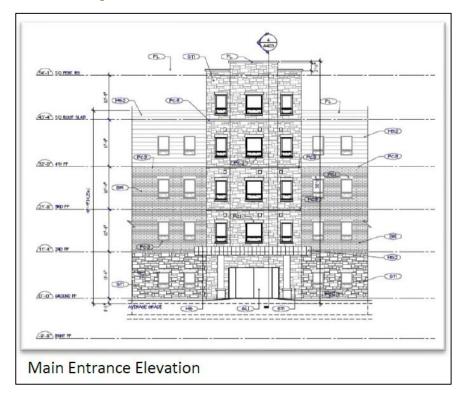

Removal of the 1872 St. Mary's Catholic Church rectory and construction of a new, one storey, 423 sq. m rectory building generally on the same footprint



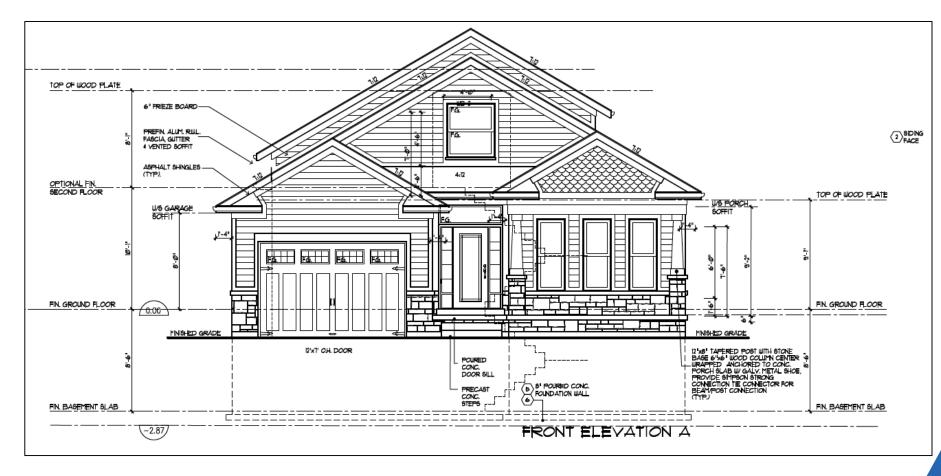
