Re: Proposed Niagara Escarpment Plan Amendment PS 215 18 Sideroad 26/27, Township of Clearview, County of Simcoe Response from Township of Clearview and Revised Amendment

The Niagara Escarpment Commission (NEC) previously circulated a Request for Comments regarding the proposed Niagara Escarpment Plan Amendment (NEPA) for Sideroad 26/27 in the Township of Clearview. According to our records, you submitted a comment on the proposed NEPA. We are now providing an update.

Attached to this letter are:

- Revised wording for the proposed NEPA that was prepared by the solicitor for the Township and received in April 2020;
- A letter from Burnside and Associates, consultant to the Township, also received in April 2020.

In order to prepare for the next stage in the NEPA process, we are asking that you review the attached documents and advise the NEC if you have any further comments and if you are in support of, or opposed to, the proposed NEPA. We would appreciate receiving your comments by **June 8, 2020**.

A process in underway to join the proposed NEPA with the Development Permit application that was already appealed to the Environmental Review Tribunal to have one combined hearing. After a recent Pre-hearing, the Hearing Officer gave direction to the parties to the hearing that the process needs to move forward. Before the hearing can occur, however, the NEC must refer the NEPA to the Tribunal. That is why we are now asking for your opinion on the revised wording of the NEPA and on whether the consultant's response addresses your comments or concerns expressed previously.
