

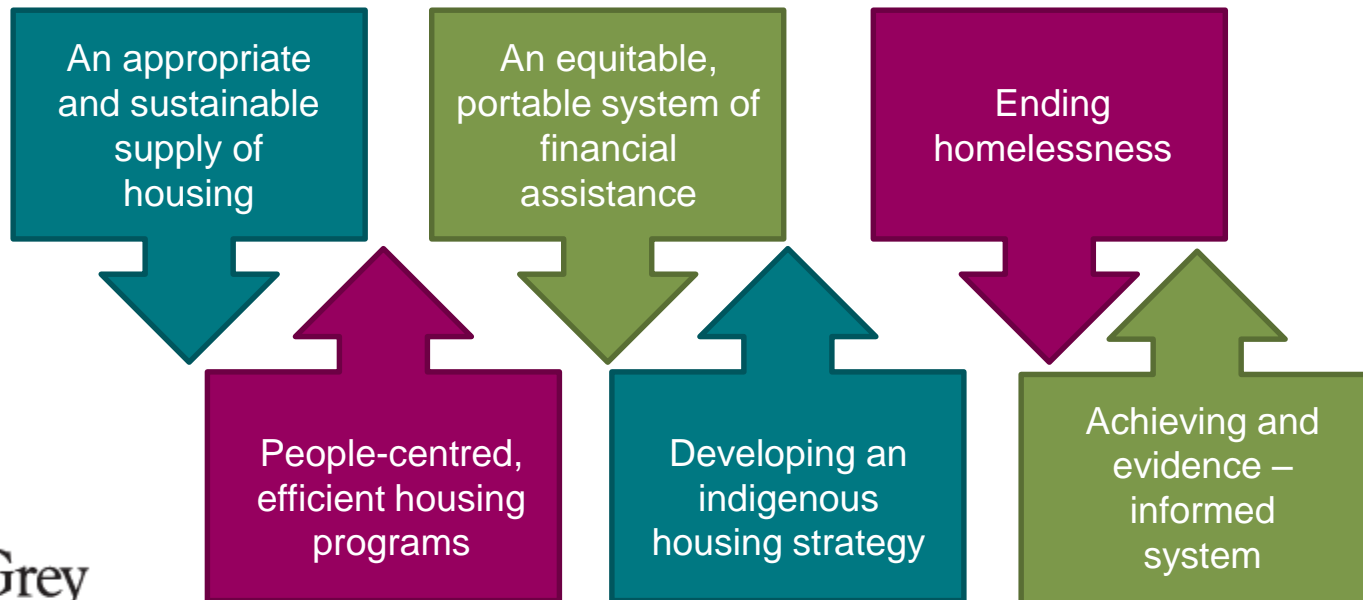
Update of Long Term Affordable Housing Strategy

Every person has an affordable, suitable and adequate home to provide the foundation to secure employment, raise a family and build strong communities

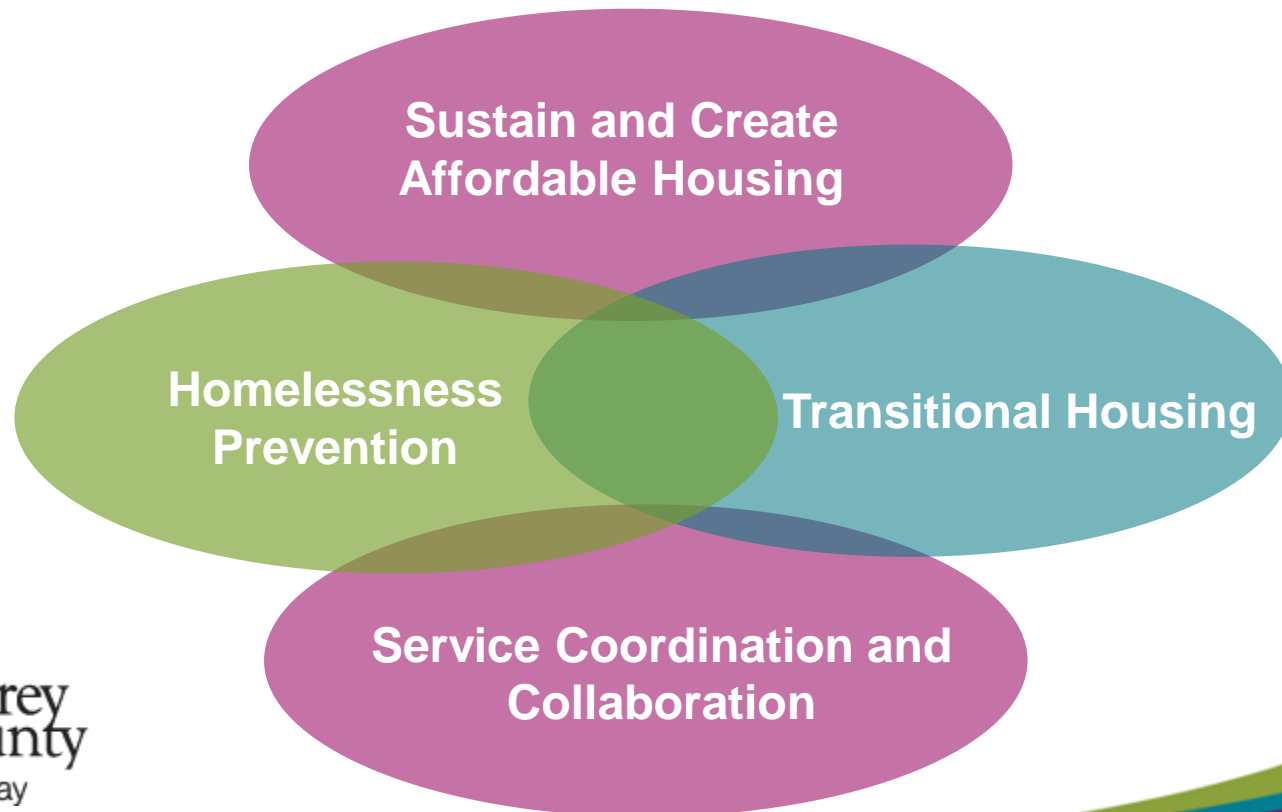
Goals:

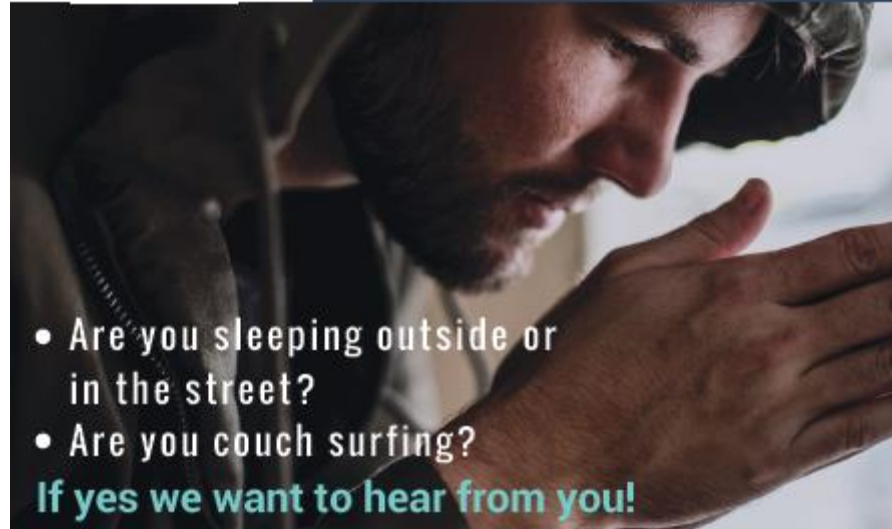
