
Thank you for your letter regarding the management of wild chervil in Grey County. I appreciate that you have brought this matter to my attention and I am pleased to respond.

Truvisit has been registered for use in Canada by the Pest Management Regulatory Agency. A proposal notice for several herbicide products containing aminocyclopyrachlor, including Truvisit (PCP #30920), was posted on the Environmental Registry on July 4, 2014, for a 30 day public consultation period.

Public comments received from this consultation were considered during classification by the Ontario Pesticide Advisory Committee. Classification of Truvisit was approved by the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change on August 18, 2014.
