Angels:

- Added three angels since February launch: now at 18 angels + 3 associates
 - o \$500 annual fee
 - o Senior business leaders, many as entrepreneurs themselves
 - o Goal is to attract Angels from all areas of Grey and Bruce
- ➤ Approximately \$6 million of investment money available from angels
- Established as Ontario Not-for-Profit; governed by volunteer Board
- Primary focus is high-growth companies in Grey-Bruce watershed. Preference for companies demonstrating traction; in succession situations; scalable startups; businesses willing to relocate or establish presence here
- ➤ Industry sectors of interest include: technology; manufacturing; agriculture and food; health; energy; seniors services
- Community benefit as important as ROI to Angels
- ➤ Work collaboratively within private and public sector ecosystem
- ➤ Held first meeting in April. Received "Angel 101" training by founding member of Golden Triangle Angel Network (KW)
- ➤ Heard presentations from three local applicant companies: one proceeding to due diligence stage. Next applicant presentations in June
