**Subject:** Award of RFT-TS-06-14 Grey Roads 13, 14, 40 and 109 Microsurfacing  
**Status:** Recommendation adopted by Committee as presented per Resolution TAPS42-14; Endorsed by County Council April 1, 2014 per Resolution CC52-14;

### Recommendation(s)

**WHEREAS the 2014 budget for Grey Roads 13, 14, 40 and 109 microsurfacing is \$571,918, which consists of design, tendering, construction, inspection and quality assurance;**

**AND WHEREAS RFT-TS-06-14 for Grey Roads 13, 14, 40 and 109 microsurfacing was issued on Friday, January 24, 2014 and closed on Thursday, February 13, 2014;**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT TR-TAPS-23-14, being a report containing the tender results for RFT-TS-06-14, be received;**

**AND THAT the tender RFT-TS-06-14 for microsurfacing Grey Roads 13, 14, 40 and 109 be awarded to MSO Construction Limited, for a total cost of \$485,257.26, excluding HST;**

**AND FURTHER THAT 10% contingency and 5% contract administration and quality assurance, be added to the total project expenditure for a revised project cost to the County of Grey of \$ 567,900, net HST.**

### Background

The Tender for the Grey Roads 13, 14, 40 and 109 Microsurfacing was posted to the County website from Friday January 24, 2014 until Thursday February 13, 2014 (closing date). Grey County completed Type II microsurfacing in 2013 and were satisfied with the results. Field reviews indicate the microsurfacing has been holding up very well over the winter.

The bid summary is listed below:

RFT-TS-06-14 – Grey Roads 13 (4.26 kms), 14 (6.82 kms), 40 (2.85 kms) and 109 (6.96 kms) microsurfacing.

It is recommended that RFT-TS-06-14 be awarded to MSO Construction Limited in the amount of \$485,257.26.

## Financial / Staffing / Legal / Information Technology Considerations

Microsurfacing will be awarded to MSO Construction Limited for the total amount of \$493,797.78 net HST. It is anticipated that the additional engineering costs will be approximately five percent (5%) of the tender value or \$24,700 and the contingency costs will be approximately ten percent (10%) of the tender value or \$49,400. As a result, the total projected cost for this project is expected to be approximately \$567,900. Therefore this project is anticipated to be approximately \$4,000 under the budget of \$571,918.
