By-Law 5101-21

A By-law to Enter into a Donation of Land Agreement with Everett Alexander Hall and Marylon Lynda Hall for Lands To Be Used as a Regional Agriculture Learning and Demonstration Site

WHEREAS Section 8 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, as amended, provides that a municipality has the authority to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and enables the municipality to respond to municipal issues;

WHEREAS the Council of the County of Grey adopted the recommendations of the Committee of the Whole at its January 9, 2020 meeting to proceed with establishing a Regional Agricultural Learning and Demonstration Site adjacent to Grey Roots; and

WHEREAS the Memorandum of Understanding in respect of the establishment of the Regional Agricultural Learning and Demonstration Site includes the donation and transfer of lands adjacent to Grey Roots Museum and Archives from Mr. and Mrs. Hall to the County of Grey;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF GREY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Warden and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute:
 - a.) a Donation of Land Agreement between Everett Alexander Hall and Marylon Lynda Hall, as the donors, and The Corporation of the County of Grey, as the recipient, for those lands described in Schedule 'A' attached hereto, and
 - b.) all other documents necessary to complete the donation contemplated thereby.
2. The Donation of Land Agreement referred to in Clause 1 is attached as Schedule 'B' and forms and becomes part of this By-law.
3. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
