## Recommendation

## Background and Discussion

Grey County Paramedic Services provides outerwear to paramedic staff as part of its obligation under the current collective agreement. The most recent purchase of winter coats occurred in 2020 as part of a five-year replacement cycle due to normal wear and tear.

Staff is requesting permission to donate the old coats that are still of useable quality to charitable organizations within Grey County for continued use. In previous years with great success, this same initiative was utilized and all coats were distributed to those in need.

All paramedic identifiers and cresting will be removed prior to distribution.
