Recommendation(s)

WHEREAS Harold Sutherland Construction Ltd. (HSC) , at its cost, is required to construct an entrance and additional lanes on Grey Road 4 to safely accommodate the proposed Hooper pit located on Grey Road 4 Con 1 NDR Pt Lot 16 Lot 17 to 18, in the Township of West Grey, adjacent to Grey Road 4;

AND WHEREAS a Road Occupancy agreement has been written and mutually agreed upon, that identifies HSC's and Grey County's responsibilities;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Report TR-TAPS-49-14 be received;

AND THAT a by-law be prepared authorizing the Warden and Clerk to execute the Grey Road 4 Occupancy Agreement with HSC.

Background

Harold Sutherland Construction Ltd. (HSC) has received approvals to begin operation at the Hooper Pit on Grey Road 4, Con 1 NDR Pt Lot 16 Lot 17 to 18 in the Township of West Grey. As part of the Hooper Pit approval, HSC agreed to construct additional lanes on Grey Road 4, to accommodate the Hooper Pit traffic.

HSC will assume the role of the constructor and as such, a Road Occupancy agreement is required. In accordance with the Road Occupancy Agreement, HSC shall complete the following work at its cost prior to hauling any aggregate for the public:

- Construct the commercial entrance.

- Complete upgrades to Grey Road 4 including 226m of slip around and turning lanes and 225m of turning tapers.

HSC wishes to complete the work as soon as the Road Occupancy Agreement and Encroachment permit are signed.

HSC has submitted signed engineering drawings verifying that the design meets the applicable safety standards.

HSC is responsible for retaining a mutually acceptable Consultant Engineer to provide field inspection of the work completed and verify that the work was completed in accordance with the design.

HSC shall be responsible for submitting a letter of credit for the value of the work.

The Grey County Solicitor has reviewed and approved the agreement.

Considerations

The agreement will identify the responsibilities of the HSC, and Grey County to minimize future concerns regarding financial and legal issues. It will also ensure the safety of the travelling public.
