It is my understanding that the County is giving \$1.2 million dollars to TBM to be forwarded to BMAHC for their Gateway project. Not a good idea. Site has noise and odour problems and may not be approved by the Ministry of the Environment. Would suggest that the funds be forwarded with the stipulation that none of these monies be allocated to the Gateway project until the Ministry approves the project. There is a good chance that it will not get approval and the money spent will have been wasted.

As an aside you should be aware there is growing opposition to this project proceeding as people become aware of it's impact on our town. The problem is the location, location, location. Why would you build a major public housing project within a 100 meters of a wastewater treatment plant and three sewage lagoons in a rapidly growing community with plans to double the wastewater capacity over the next few years? Can't get the Mayor or his sidekick to provide an answer. Maybe some of these questions should be asked at County Council?

Lot's to worry about how TBM is proceeding on this project. Just wanted you to know all is not well in TBM.
