Subject: Award of RFT-TS-06-16 Grey Road 12 Pulverize and Hot Mix Paving
Status: Recommendation adopted by Committee as presented per Resolution TAPS43-16; Endorsed by County Council April 5, 2016 per Resolution CC45-16;

Recommendation(s)

WHEREAS the 2016 budget included \$2,574,974 for pulverizing and paving, guiderail replacements, design, tendering, construction inspection and quality assurance on Grey Road 12 from 0.34 kilometres north of Sideroad 4A to Grey Road 40 (in the Municipality of Grey Highlands);

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Report TR-TAPS-22-16 being a report containing the tender results for RFT-TS-06-16 be received;

AND THAT RFT-TS-06-16 be awarded to E.C. King Contracting for a bid price of \$2,044,458.23, excluding HST;

AND THAT with 5% contingency, 5% engineering and quality assurance allowances added to the tender price, the revised estimated project cost is \$2,288,484.76 net HST.

Background

In 2015, Grey County Transportation Services forwarded the proposed 2016 construction program to the member municipalities in Grey and inquired if they were interested in tendering work together to increase the size of the projects and make the work more appealing to an increased number of larger contractors. Grey Highlands had work planned for the immediate area around the Grey Road 12 project. Grey Highlands and Grey County staff completed a field visit together to observe the projects and Grey Highlands forwarded

the contract limits and proposed quantities to Grey County. Grey County incorporated the additional work into the Grey Road 12 tender as schedules B and C and Grey County purchasing tendered the work.

The parameters for the tender are as follows:

- The three schedules (A, B and C) will be awarded to the lowest **total** bid as it was felt that the prices would only improve if one contractor could do all the work.
- Each owner will be responsible for their own inspection, although meetings and some quality assurance may be performed on all schedules at once.
- Grey County Council and Grey Highlands Council are each responsible for their own award and are under no obligation to award the work.

Schedule A (Grey County portion) includes pulverizing and paving a 17.75 kilometre section of Grey Road 12 from 0.34 kilometres north of Sideroad 4A to Grey Road 40. This schedule also includes culvert replacements and intersection improvements at Goring.

Schedules B and C are for being hot mix paving (8.4 kilometre) on behalf of Grey Highlands on Sideroads 22A and 22B respectively.

The tender for the pulverize and hot mix paving of Grey Road 12 was posted on the County of Grey's website from Thursday, February 4, 2016 until Tuesday, March 1, 2016. The bids are shown below:

It is recommended to award RFT-TS-08-16 to E.C. King Contracting. Schedule A (Grey Road 12) tender price was **\$2,044,458.23**.

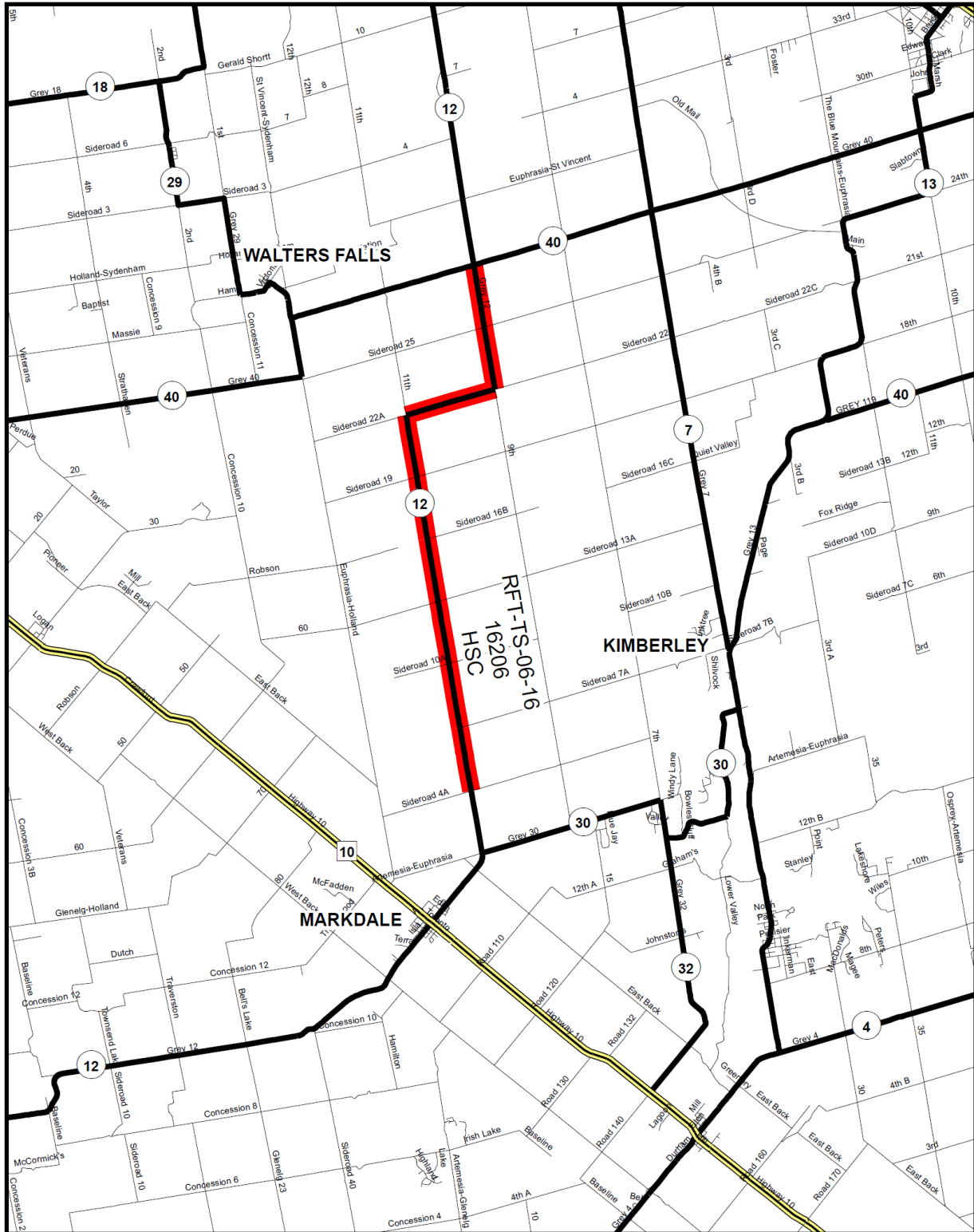
